

Master's Degree in Adult-Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner

Description

The program develops generalist nurses to provide specialized advanced practice care to work in direct collaboration with physicians in the treatment and management of the care process for adult and geriatric patients with acute and life-threatening chronic problems, including those in hospital, intensive care and life support settings in diverse settings in Puerto Rico.

The program provides for the training of nurses in Adult-Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner in who can treat patients with undifferentiated symptoms, as well as those with established diagnoses and under investigation; will be able to order diagnostic tests for the purpose of formulating clinical diagnoses; order non-pharmacological treatments and establish the treatment plan according to the needs of the patients.

The Adult-Gerontology Acute Care Nurse Practitioner will manage with respect, willingness and clarity the assessment, investigation and delivery of clinical service to patients with chronic and acute problems, including patients admitted to the hospital in critical care. Promotes critical thinking in the discernment, planning and delivery of patient health care services with the highest professional standards.
